## **Surveyor Exam Day Items**

## **Approved Calculators**

Devices or material that might compromise the security of the examination or disrupt the examination process are **not permitted**. Only models of calculators approved by the Board are permitted in the exam room. No other models of calculators or variations of the models listed below are permitted in the exam room.

Approved calculators permitted into the exam area are:

- Hewlett-Packard HP 33s and HP 35s models, but no others.
- Casio All fx-115 models. Any Casio calculator must contain fx-115 in its model name.
- Texas Instruments All TI-30X and TI-36X models. (Any Texas Instruments calculator must contain either TI-30X or TI-36X in its model name.)

## **Prohibited Items**

Devices having QWERTY keypad arrangement similar to a typewriter or keyboard are not permitted. Devices with communication or text-editing capabilities are prohibited from the exam room. These include but are not limited to cameras, cell phones (please leave your cell phone at home or in your car) desktop, hand-held, laptop and palmtop computers; databanks; data collectors, organizers; pagers or beepers; PDA's; radios; headsets; tape players; portable fax machines; calculator watches; reproduction equipment; electronic dictionaries; electronic translators; and recorders. Any prohibited device found in an examinee's possession after the examination begins will be confiscated, the examinee will be dismissed from the exam room, and his or her examination will not be scored.

Examinees are also prohibited from bringing the following items into the exam room: weapons of any kind; including pocketknives; or tobacco products. No examinee is permitted to wear a hat or hood of any kind during the exam.

This is a closed book examination. No reference materials or paper of any kind, with exception of the Exam Authorization Form, are permitted in the testing area. The Exam Authorization Form will be collected from you at the end of the exam day.

## **Permissible Items**

Pencils - #2 pencils to fill in Scantron sheets. Pencils of any kind, highlighters, straight edges, protractors, triangles, small scales, rules, erasers, and other materials that aid drawing are permissible items. If you chose to bring any of these items in a container it must be clear. A clear Ziploc type freezer bag can be used. No other containers, bags, backpacks, or luggage will be permitted.

Examinees may bring snacks and drinks (nonalcoholic) provided they do not distract others from or disrupt the exam. All snacks and drinks must be kept on the floor during the exam.

Personal items are the sole responsibility of the examinee. Neither the Board, nor the site facility, will be responsible for any lost, misplaced, or stolen items.
